Dolphins Swim Team: **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The following code of conduct applies to all Ocean Community YMCA – Westerly/Pawcatuck Branch Dolphin Swim Team Members. Any swim team member who, in the opinion of the coach or coaches, acts in a manner that is contrary to the code below, may be asked to leave the event immediately, suspended or removed from the team.

1. The Dolphin Swim Team demands respect for your family, yourself, your coaches, and your team. It is paramount to your success as a human being and to this team.
2. Any swimmer who is known to use, possess, distribute or under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or tobacco is subject to suspension from the team.
3. Profanity, inappropriate jokes, and any kind of harassment in the presence of children or parents are prohibited.
4. At all team functions, whether practice, meets or social gatherings, we expect each swimmer/parent to behave in such a way that their actions reflect positively on the team.
5. If a swimmer/parent has a problem or difference of opinion with a coach, they are expected to resolve the issue with the coach immediately in a professional manner.
6. If the swimmer is expected to attend a swim meet and is unable to attend, the parent is expected to contact the Head Coach in advance.
7. It is the responsibility of the swimmer/parent to stay up to date with meet information/team events by checking the team Web Site (Web Site Address), and reading the bulletin board.
8. Swimmers are required to show up for practice and be prepared to enter the water on time. The starting time for practice means that you dressed, you have your equipment ready to go and you are prepared to practice to the best of your abilities.
